PGY1 Pharmacy Resident

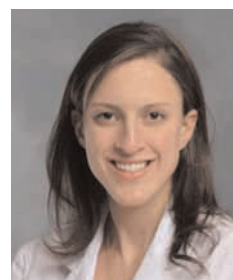
