#### **Hospital Locations**

Tampa General Hospital: The flagship academic medical center, a 982-bed hospital located on Davis Islands in Tampa, Fla. Home to 21 specialized Institutes and service lines, TGH offers a comprehensive range of advanced, high-acuity care. The hospital is also home to the region's only Level I trauma center, a comprehensive stroke center, and the nation's number one transplant center in the nation.

**TGH North:** Established in 2023, TGH North includes three community hospitals in Hernando and Citrus Counties:

**TGH Rehabilitation Hospital:** A state-of-the-art, 80-bed acute rehabilitation hospital dedicated to the treatment and recovery of individuals who have experienced debilitating effects of a severe injury or illness.

**TGH Behavioral Health Hospital:** Opened in March 2025, this 96-bed facility is Florida's first behavioral health teaching hospital and provides a higher level of care for patients in crisis due to a mental health condition.

#### Off-Campus Outpatient Services

The Specialty Care Center at Healthpark is a multidisciplinary outpatient clinic serving Hillsborough County. The Genesis Women's Center at Healthpark offers care for women including routine check-ups, high-risk or normal pregnancy care, and treatment of endometriosis, chronic pelvic pain and painful or irregular menstruation. The Pediatric Center at Healthpark offers a full range of care for all the developmental stages of a child's life from birth, to well-baby care, and childhood illnesses through 17 years.

**TGH Outpatient Center:** Serving both adults and children, this location provides 24/7 emergency care, outpatient rehab, surgery, pharmacy, lab services, and primary/specialty care.

**TGH Ambulatory Surgery Centers:** TGH Surgery Centers at Brandon and Morsani offer same-day surgical care in a safe, convenient outpatient setting.

**TGH Medical Village:** For adults 18+, the TGH Medical Village offers primary care and outpatient rehab services, including pelvic floor therapy and chronic pain management.

**TGH Urgent Care powered by Fast Track:** Providing walk-in care for patients 3 months and older, these clinics treat non-emergency conditions like minor fractures, infections, and earaches.

**Tampa General Medical Group (TGMG):** A multispecialty physician group with locations across Hillsborough, Pinellas, and Pasco counties, specializing in family medicine, pediatrics, endocrinology, oncology, surgery, and more.

**TGH Imaging:** Offering advanced radiology services at outpatient centers across several counties, including 3D mammography, MRI, CT lung screening, and PET/CT. Accredited by the American College of Radiology.

**Tampa General Provider Network (TGPN):** A clinically integrated network of leading providers connecting patients to experts across community and academic settings for coordinated, high-quality care.

# **Education**

Tampa General is affiliated with the USF Health Morsani College of Medicine and serves as the primary teaching hospital for the university. About 700 residents/fellows are assigned to Tampa General Hospital for specialty training in areas ranging from general internal medicine to neurosurgery. In addition, USF medical students, nurses and physical therapy students receive part of their training at Tampa General. Faculty from the USF Health Morsani College of Medicine admit and care for patients at Tampa General Hospital as do private practice physicians, many of whom also serve as adjunct clinical faculty. Tampa General also serves as a teaching hospital to students in many disciplines from several area schools.

## **Community Engagement**
