Requirements

- Bachelor's of Science in Nursing (BSN) required
- · Licensure to practice as a Registered Nurse in the State of FL
- BLS certification (American Heart Association)
- Physical requirements: continuous standing and walking, heavy lifting, pushing/pulling, bending, stooping, wearing surgical masks



RN PERIOPERATIVE TRANSITION PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Section 1: **Perioperative Foundations**

Under the guidance of an experienced perioperative nurse educator, Perioperative Transition Program (PTP) nurses will:

- Utilize blended learning approach (online, classroom, clinical) to build core foundation of perioperative nursing, using the Association of periOperative Registered Nurses (AORN) Periop 101[™] Curriculum.
- Complete daily required homework and reading assignments
- Complete weekly tests
- Attend classroom lectures and hands-on OR skills labs
- Complete clinicals in the operating room under direct guidance of perioperative nurse and surgical tech preceptors
- Achieve basic competency in the scrub role with surgical tech preceptors in procedures
- Pass AORN Periop 101 FINAL EXAM

RN Perioperative Transition Program Requirements

Section 2:

OR Service Line Specialties

Under the guidance of an experienced perioperative nurse and surgical tech preceptors, PTP nurses will:

- Complete clinical rotation track in the OR Monday-Friday
- · Rotate through specialty services lines
- Obtain required preceptor/clinician evaluations and feedback
- Achieve Core competencies in specialty service lines in both the circulating and scrub roles.

RNs will function in OR circulating nurse and scrub roles in the operating room upon successful completion of the program.

- Nine-month commitment to intense, supportive, structured blended learning program
- Commit a minimum of six hours per week of required online module/reading/study assignments
- Commit to required stay late and on-call assignments (must live within 30 minutes of hospital for call requirements)
- Flexibility with shift assignment and OR department assignment upon successful completion of program
- Minimum two-year commitment to TGH Surgical Services Division after program completion
