A total of 989 patients were admitted to Tampa General’s Inpatient Rehabilitation Program from January to December 2017.

*Comprehensive diagnosis category includes but is not limited to individuals with a diagnosis of burn, transplant, ventricular assistive device (VAD), oncology, cardiac, amputee, and neurological diagnosis other than stroke.

Patients were seen for a combination of physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech therapy for a minimum of 3 hours a day, 5 days a week; or a minimum of 15 hours over the course of 7 days. Nursing, psychology and recreational therapy services were also provided.

Average age of patients: 62 years

Gender: 54% male 46% female

Patient improvement in predicted ability to function independently:

29 points (average)

Therapy time: Patients received an average of 3.25 hours of therapy per day (5 out of 7 days a week).
